

OUR AIM:

“To secure the restoration of the Cambrian Railways in order to preserve the unique railway heritage of Oswestry and to provide a visitor attraction of national significance.”

The Trust owns much of the track-bed between Llyncllys Junction and Pant, and will initially run a short shuttle service here. The Trust is working towards the re-opening of the railway between Llyncllys and Oswestry as soon as circumstances permit, later extending to Gobowen in the north and Llanymynech in the south. A vital part of the project is the use of Oswestry station building, the former headquarters offices of the Cambrian Railways Company, and as much as possible of the other remaining railway infrastructure in the area.

**The Trust will welcome applications for individual membership from any person sharing these aims – whether he or she will be able to help with practical work, or administration and publicity, or simply become an armchair supporter.**

The Trust has the support of Oswestry Borough Council, Oswestry Town Council, Gobowen & Selattyn Parish Council, and Oswestry Rural Parish Council as nominating members.
